| A Regular Diploma is awarded to those students who earn the 22 prescribed credits and have a satisfactory record of attendance and discipline. |  |
| :---: | :---: |
| Math: 4 credits | Including Algebra 1, II, Geometry and a fourth higher level math course (Students must be enrolled in a mathernatics course each school year.) |
| English: 4 credits | English 1, English II, English III and English IV |
| Science: 3 credits | Including Biology. Chemistry or Physics, and a third lab course |
| Social Studies: 3 credits | World History and Geography, U.S. History. Economics, U.S. Government or appropriate AP course |
| Wellness: 1 credit |  |
| Physical Education: 0.5 |  |
| Personal Finance: 0.5 credits |  |
| Foreign Language: 2 credits | Two credits must be the same language. |
| Fine Arts: 1 credit |  |
| Elective Focus: 3 credits | Includes three credits in any one of the following: Math and Science, Career and Technical Education, Fine Arts/Hurnanities, JROTC, Advanced Placernent (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) |
| Each graduate must have completed 180 hours of computer education at some time during the student's educational career that can be documented or verified and must establish technology literacy prior to graduation. Any student who transfers from another state during his/her senior year is exempt from this requirement. |  |
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Notes about registration:

- The core class requirements are non-negotiable.
- 4 math, 4 English, 3 Social Studies, personal finance .5 , Wellness $1.5=16$
- All students are required to take 2 years of a foreign language $=2$
- Additionally, all students are required to take 1 year of fine arts $=1$
- All students must choose a focus path of study beyond the core $=3$
- The total available credits for high school are 7 classes $\times 4$ years or 28 total credits.
- A student who takes marching band for one year can exempt . 5 of the wellness requirement.

At this point, a student has 2.5 credits or $21 / 2$ years of available credit or electives remaining.

With just 1 fine arts elective and 2.5 remaining years of available credit, how can I do band for 4 years?

## Some general observations before we continue:

1) The AP focus path allows a student to "double dip" on Credits allowing for students to complete the general requirements as well as the AP focus concurrently.
a. Meaning, AP English 3 \& 4 can count for 2 of the 4 required English Classes
b. AP Statistics Calculus $A B$ or $B C$ can count for 2 or 3 of the required math classes
c. AP Biology, Chemistry, and Physics can count for 3 of the 3 Science requirements.
2) Studies show that, in general, a student's junior year is generally their most difficult year in many aspects.
3) Study halls, while useful, can also be carefully managed over four years to maximize a student's schedule flexibility.
4) You can still take AP classes even if you don't declare the AP focus.
5) These are not the only ways to manage the schedule. You can move the wellness classes around to create balance in your schedule.
See the charts below to schedule your students 4 year plan to include band all 4 years regardless of the FOCUS you choose.
The easiest two are:
Humanities: Any 3 humanities credits completes the focus, so choose to take band for 3 humanities and band for
1 fine arts and complete the focus and the core requirements concurrently.

AP/IB Focus: Any 3 AP credits completes the AP focus, so choose to "double dip" and complete the focus and the core requirements concurrently.

The remaining 3 are a little more tricky as they require you to give up 1 year of study hall. Strategically placed to avoid the junior year, this will not be a problem.

Math and Science: Any 3 math or science credits, depending on the choice, completes the focus. So, choose to take band for band for 1 fine arts, band for 2 of the electives, and band during 1 study hall and complete the focus and the core requirements concurrently.

***Notice that you have 3 years to choose to have band instead of a study hall. Junior year is not recommended. Any choice to have seven periods with no study hall requires a parent override form.

CTE: Any 3 CTE credits from the same CTE discipline in sequential order completes the focus. So, choose to take band for band for 1 fine arts, band for 2 of the electives, and band during 1 study hall and complete the focus and the core requirements concurrently. WAIT to take the CTE classes beginning your sophomore year so that you can take them without a gap.
